

Guidelines for Road Groups to Apply for matching DRCI Funds

(As of May 15, 2021)

As part of the Emergency Access Initiative, the DRCI Board of Directors has compiled the following list of guidelines for DRCI Road Groups who wish to apply for matching DRCI funds:

1. The group MUST have the involvement of the majority of shareholders in the area where the work is being completed.
2. Road Group must form an association with a separate checking account (no personal checking accounting allowed)
3. Monies awarded must be used for main artery roads (no private driveways)
4. Each group must define the parameters of their project (from where to where)
5. Copy of invoices for project need to be provided to DRCI. (The DRCI board of directors wishes to keep track of the money spent on improving DRCI roads)
6. DRCI requests before and after pictures of the project
7. Any permits required must be in the name of the road group and must be applied for before the project begins.

Each established road group may apply for up to a \$3,000 match by DRCI

*** As a bonus: In 2021 DRCI will grant \$1.33 for each dollar raised by the Road Groups; capping out at a matching grant of \$4,000 for a group match of \$3,000.

Deadline for application of funds for 2021 is July 15, 2021, the deadline to use these funds is October 1, 2020.

This project will be re-evaluated in January 2022.

All decisions by the DRCI board are final.
